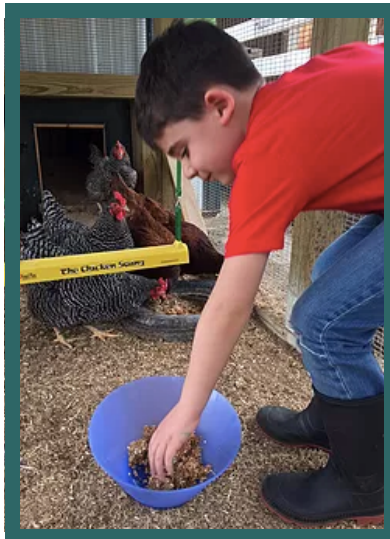


FARM SCIENCE

Course Outline:

- Through hands-on exploration students will learn topics such as animal husbandry, small and large ruminant digestion, history of farming, the soil cycle, composting, and the science of planting and harvesting.
- Students in the Fall 2018 course will gain a strong understanding of the animals and plants in the farming/ agricultural industry through: readings, hands on activities/ experiments, observations and journaling.
